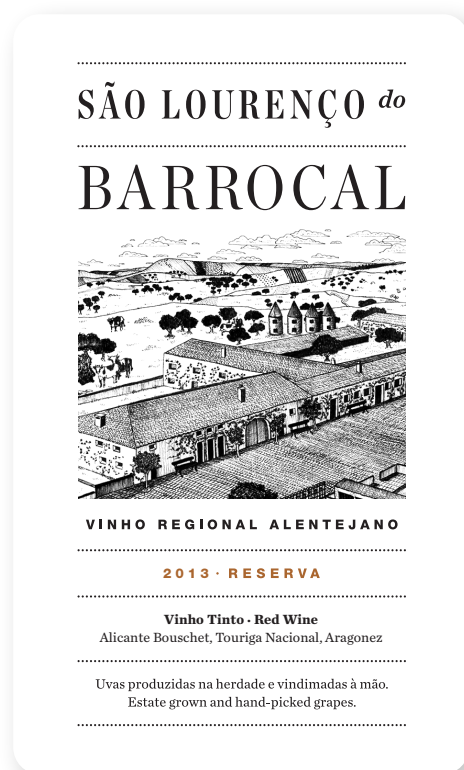

DENOMINATION OF ORIGIN Regional Alentejo Wine

HARVEST YEAR 2013

AGE OF VINES 3 years / 28 years (Aragonez)

SOIL GEOLOGY Granitic terrain

GRAPE VARIETIES Alicante Bouschet, Touriga Nacional, Aragonez

VINIFICATION Manual harvesting, separated by grape variety, with sorting, destemming, crushing, pressing, alcoholic and malolactic fermentation in concrete vat, at a controlled temperature, and ageing of 18 months in French oak barrels.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION Alcohol/Volume: 14,5% Total acidity: 5,1 g/l pH: 3,8

TASTE Of dark ruby color, almost opaque and deep, it is a wine with great ageing potential. With a full-bodied profile, it has notes of forest fruits and a very intricate nose. In the mouth, it presents intense tannins and a good complexity. Aftertaste of long persistence. Suited to accompany complex meals.
